- Operate our own facilities in a safe, efficient and environmentally sensitive manner.
- Strive to continuously improve our environmental performance based on achievement of established environmental goals and ensure compliance with all applicable legislation.

Community:

- Respect the sensitivities and cultural heritage of communities within the influence of projects managed by Hatch.

Sustainable Development:
